

## Langford Village CP School Remote Learning Home – School Agreement

### ***School will...***

- Provide a combination of planned activities and tasks i.e. Purple Mash, TT Rock stars, Numbots and Accelerated Reader.
- Provide some recorded lesson inputs to access via Google Classroom.
- Respond to completed tasks via Purple Mash email and/or marking of work online.
- Contact families that have not been engaging in remote learning to check in on pupils and their families.
- Support pupils requesting help via Purple Mash.
- Look to provide some live learning in the future.

### ***Pupils will...***

- Access their learning on a daily basis, at an appropriate time.
- Endeavour to follow a routine of getting up, dressed and ready to complete home learning.
- Complete learning tasks, Purple Mash tasks and activities on TT Rockstars and Numbots.
- Watch recorded lessons at an appropriate time during the day, prior to completing set tasks.
- Pupils attending school, may still follow the above guidance for access to any home learning before and after school or during a period of absence.

### **When live learning commences, guidance below must be followed:**

- Parent/carer must be present for safeguarding purposes.
- Class expectations still apply – always adhere to the School Behaviour Policy.
- Focus on learning during the live lesson.
- Cameras must be on and pupils must be appropriately dressed e.g. no Pyjamas.
- Use 'raise hand' or chat function to participate in the lesson, parent/carer may support.
- Remain on mute unless requested to unmute.
- Find a quiet place to join the lesson, blur the background and have pencil and paper available (preferably not in a bedroom).
- Complete follow up tasks.

### ***Parents/Carers will...***

- Ensure that their child/children are following the daily timetable and completing their work.
- Ensure that their child/children only use the platforms for educational purposes.
- Be present for any live learning sessions for safeguarding purposes.
- Monitor the use of their child/children's devices for access to other inappropriate online materials/apps.
- Encourage non-screen activities where possible when not engaged in on-line learning.
- Not record any lessons or share recorded lessons on other platforms. Scrutiny of teaching on social media/online will not be tolerated.
