Langford House System
Year 1 - 6

Langford Village Primary School prides itself on high expectations for learning and high expectations of behaviour in school.

The school house system works in conjunction with the school 'Behaviour Policy' to reinforce and create a team and family ethos for all members of the school family.

How the house system works:

- There are four houses: Badger - red, Deer - blue, Fox – green and Otter – yellow
- Each house collects house points from a variety of in-school house events e.g. P.E and Sports Events
- Individuals can gain house points from modelling good behaviour and any element of the 'Langford Life Rules'
- Any member of staff or visitors can award a house point, with an explanation of the reason for reward
- All house points are posted into the tubes in reception and counted on a monthly basis

Expectations:

- Every classroom will have a house display to enable all children to take pride and know which house they are in
- Whole school display with house point tubes in the reception area of school, including the staff attached to each house
- Enable all children to work together as a team
- House point counters available to all staff and visitors
- Monthly total and reward shared in whole class assembly
