

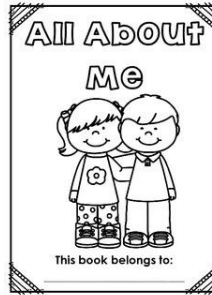

Challenge: clap your hands behind your back before catching the ball.

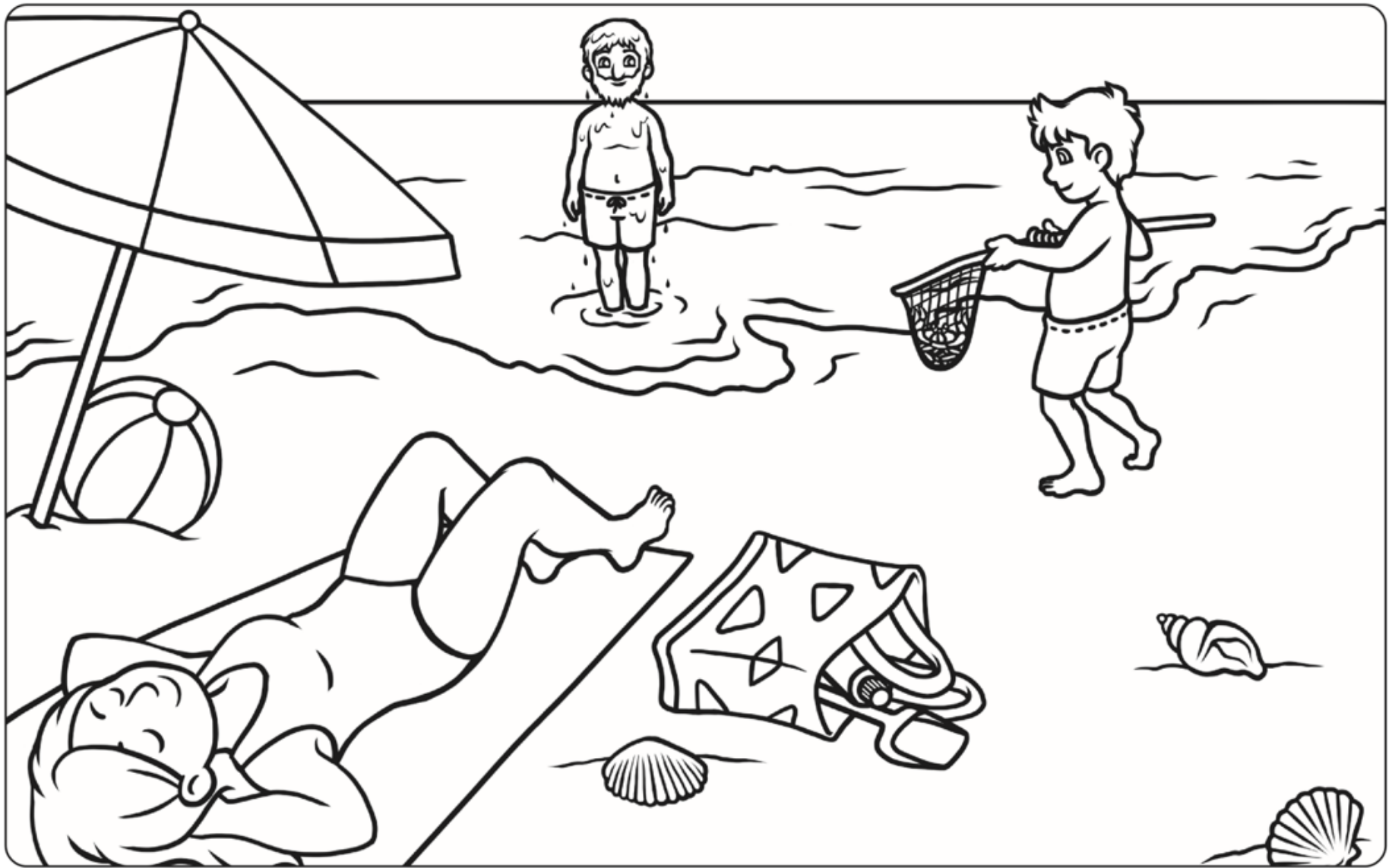
### Art
