Homework Deadlines: Monday 11th May and Monday 29th June. Choose one activity from the grid to complete for each deadline. You have around five weeks to complete a piece of work so take time to complete it as a project. A piece of writing is expected to accompany each piece. The topics below are just suggestions for ideas you could work on but feel free to research any aspect of the subjects we are learning in class.

Viking recipes and cooking

An English/DT based project

Investigate the types of meals prepared and cooked in the Viking age. Can you prepare a meal fit for a Viking warrior? Take photographs to share with the class and write out your recipe and method – you could even tea stain paper for an old-fashioned effect!

Habitat in a shoe box

A SCIENCE based Project

In term 6, will be exploring different types of habitats and animals. Choose an animal or group of animals that interests you and design their habitat in a shoe box. This could be a bird in a nest, an orca in the ocean or an ant in an ant hill.



Misty mountains

A GEOGRAPHY based Project

Research a mountain range from across the world. Create a fact file or poster about your chosen mountain range. Can you include maps or illustrations?



Mountain Art

An ART based Project

Create a painting or picture in the style of Katsushika Hokusai.

He was a Japanese artist, famous for his work on Mount Fuji.
Can you use his image as inspiration for your own version of his painting?



Viking Gods and Goddesses Game

A HISTORY/DT based Project

Can you create a game about the Viking Gods and Goddesses?

This could be a card game such as Top Trumps, a board game such as God Monopoly, or could even be a game on Purple Mash using a coding programme.



Shelter Building

A DT based Project

Design (and build?) a shelter that would be effective when climbing a mountain. Think about what you would need, the materials you would need to build it. You could make a model, a Lego shelter, create one in your home or garden or on Minecraft.

Suggested weekly steps:

Week 1

Look at the ideas on your homework menu or think of your own. Read or talk about the topic to get inspired. Choose what your project will be about and how you'll show it - maybe a fact sheet, booklet, slideshow, model or even a short play!

Week 2

Start finding out more and write down some notes. You could begin a drawing or poster too.

Week 3

Keep researching and start writing your first draft using your notes.

Week 4

Ask a grown-up or friend to read your work and give you advice. Make it even better by checking your spelling, punctuation and sentences. Then write it up neatly.

Week 5

Add your final touches! Finish any pictures or models. Ask someone to check it one last time - then hand it in knowing it's your very best!
