
Superheroes





What is an adjective?

Yesterday, we thought of adjectives to describe this orange. Today, we are going to use these adjectives and write some sentences to describe it.





We could write:



The orange looks juicy.

This sentence tells us what the orange looks like.





Think of another sentence to describe the orange and share it with your grown up.

Punctuation Pup just wants to check that you remembered to use:

Capital letters

Finger spaces

Full stops



We could extend our sentence to include more information by adding another adjective. To do this we could add a conjunction. Today, we are going to use 'and'.

Our extended sentence will now look like this:

The orange looks juicy and tastes sweet.
