<p>Geography: Investigate what causes hurricanes and volcanoes. Create fact files or posters on them.</p>	<p>D&T/Geography: Make a model of a volcano. Try to label the parts. This could also be a working model.</p> 	<p>English: Write an Acrostic Poem about a natural disaster. E.g., volcanoes, earthquakes, tsunamis</p>
<p>Fill the plastic bottle with water until it reaches around three quarters full. Add a few drops of washing up liquid. Sprinkle in a few pinches of glitter (this will make your tornado easier to see). Put the cap on tightly. Turn the bottle upside down and hold it by the neck. Quickly spin the bottle in a circular motion for a few seconds, then stop and look inside to see if you can see a mini tornado forming in the water. You might need to try it a few times before you get it working properly.</p> <p>D&T: Make your own cyclone in a bottle.
