
#### **Exclamation Marks**



## What is an exclamation mark?

Have you ever seen one in any of your reading books?

## An exclamation mark looks like this



### They can be used to show surprise or excitement.

Oops!

Wow!

Summer holidays!

I love it!

**Brilliant!** 

They can be used to add emphasis to your writing, for example a strong emotion.

"OUCH! That really hurt!"

#### They can be used with a command.

Go away!

Be quiet!

Eat your tea!

Come here!

Sit Down!

## They can be used to show someone is shouting.

"HELP!"

"STOP!"

|---------------------------------|---------------------------------|
| I love your hair.               | I love your hair!               |
| How funny you are.              | How funny you are!              |
| What a lovely pie that is.      | What a lovely pie that is!      |
| Thank you very much for coming. | Thank you very much for coming! |
| We are going on holiday.        | We are going on holiday!        |
