#### **Fireworks Printing**

#### You will need:

Black paper or card

Paint (bright colours)

Shallow trays or paper plates

Bendy drinking straws

Pipe cleaners

Sticky tape

Glitter





 First, make your printing tool. To do this, gather a small bundle of about 8 straws or pipe cleaners.



4. Create a few firework printing tools for each different colour of paint you are going to use.



2. Next, use sticky tape to tape the middle and (non-bendy) ends of the straws or pipe cleaners together to create a handle.



5. Next, squeeze a little paint into each tray or plate. Bright and neon colours work especially well! Then, press the 'arms' of the printing tools into the paint and press it onto your black paper.



3. Next, bend the ends of the straws or pipe cleaners outwards to create several 'arms'.



6. Continue printing using several different colours, overlapping the colours as desired. Once the paint has dried, dab a little glue onto the fireworks and sprinkle on a little glitter.






