Paper Plate Catherine Wheel

You will need:

A paper plate Paint

A cardboard Glitter

tube

Ribbon

A split pin/

Sticky tape

paper fastener

A pencil

Sticky tack

Scissors





1. First, paint the plate a black or dark blue colour and allow to dry.



2. Once dry, make a small hole in the centre of the plate. To do this, push a pencil through the plate, onto some sticky tack.



3. Next, make a hole near the top of the cardboard tube in the same way – it only needs to go through one side of the tube.



4. Now, push the split pin through the holes in the paper plate and the tube, then open the pin out to fasten the plate and tube together—the plate should be able to spin around!



5. Next, pour a little paint onto the centre of the plate in a few different colours and then begin slowly spinning the plate around to make the paint run around the plate! Repeat with a few different colours until the desired patterns are created.



 Once the paint drys, sprinkle a little glitter and sequins onto some wet glue to create some sparkles.



7. Once dry, cut some lengths of ribbon and attach around the edge of the plate using sticky tape.




