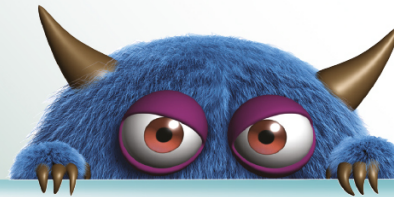
They need some 'Pet Detectives' to spend time with these animals to try and find out more about them and how to look after them.
