Take a picture of you enjoying a book in your favourite place and put it on Tapestry for us to share in class. Tell us why you like reading there.



Go on an Autumn scavenger hunt and take pictures of things you spot/collect. Can you find red and yellow leaves, a pinecone, a feather, a smooth stone, or a stick shaped like the letter Y? Upload your pictures for us to share.



Collect different shapes, colours, and sizes of leaves. Use them to make an animal, a tree, or an autumn scene. You can stick them onto paper or use crayons to make leaf rubbings.



When you're out and about, see if you can spot poppies in your community - maybe on posters, in gardens, or on people's clothes around Remembrance Day. Count how many you can find and tell us where you saw them. You could draw or take photos of them, too.



Topics title: Amazing Me!

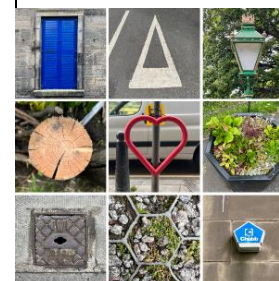
Ask an older family member to tell you a story about when they were little. What games did they play? What toys did they have? What was school like? You could draw a picture or tell us what you found most interesting about their story.
