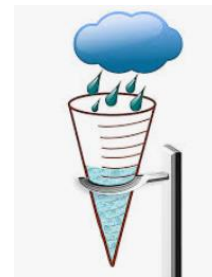

Weather Watchers: measuring rainfall

A SCIENCE based Project

- Create a way to measure the amount of rainfall (precipitation) we have each day. (check the weather report to choose a rainy week)
- Make sure it is a fair experiment.
- Record your results in a table.

A GEOGRAPHY based Project

- Research the Christmas traditions of a European country of your choice.
- Create a fact file / PowerPoint to share with the class informing us about the celebrations.



The Roman Games

A PE based Project

- Research the Roman sport of Harpastum.
- Write an instruction sheet to explain to your friends how to play in a PE lesson.



Wave Your flag!

An ART based Project

- Choose a European flag
- Recreate your chosen flag in a medium of your choice e.g. print, collage.
- You could choose ideas linked to your flag's country e.g. pasta for Italy, orange prints for Spain.
- Explain the reasons for your material/technique choices



Rocking Romans!

A MUSIC based Project

- Create a song with a Roman theme.
- You could use our classroom learning for inspiration, for example, write a song about the Gods and Goddesses or soldiers marching to war along Hadrian's Wall.
- Practise your song, write down the lyrics, and if you are feeling brave (like a Roman!) perform this to the class.



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Over the next few weeks, you'll be completing a homework project that you can feel really proud of. It's your chance to explore something fun, stick with it, and show off your amazing ideas and effort. We can't wait to see what you create, and we'd love to show it off in our classrooms!

What to include:

- **Neat presentation** – use your best handwriting or type it if you like.
- **Add something colourful** – a drawing, map, chart or picture to go with your writing.
- **Extra WOW!** – you can make something to go with your project, like a model, mask, cake, diorama, video or jewellery. Be creative!

Suggested weekly steps:

Week 1

Look at the ideas on your homework menu or think of your own. Read or talk about the topic to get inspired. Choose what your project will be about and how you'll show it - maybe a fact sheet, booklet, slideshow, model or even a short play!

Week 2

Start finding out more and write down some notes. You could begin a drawing or poster too.

Week 3

Keep researching and start writing your first draft using your notes.

Week 4

Ask a grown-up or friend to read your work and give you advice. Make it even better by checking your spelling, punctuation and sentences. Then write it up neatly.

Week 5

Add your final touches! Finish any pictures or models. Ask someone to check it one last time - then hand it in knowing it's your very best!
