"The Tiger Who Came to Tea."

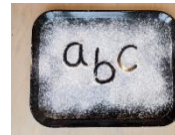
Can you write an invitation to invite your teddies to a tea party?

Reading

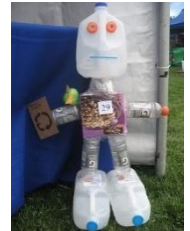
Make a cosy reading corner and use your reading diary to keep track of how many times you read this week.
